

NATIONAL QUARTET CONVENTION TIMELINE

The 2025 National Quartet Convention (NQC) of Southern Gospel Music just concluded in Pigeon Forge, Tennessee. Looking back, The Couriers were invited to sing at NQC as early as 1959 in Memphis, Tennessee. We continued appearing in Memphis and later on in Nashville, Tennessee. We retired in 1980 and then resumed singing part time in the middle 1980's. The next change of venue took the NQC to Louisville, Kentucky. We were invited to make a cameo appearance at Louisville and received a plaque thanking The Couriers for our long history in Gospel Music. In 2014, the NQC was moved to its present location in Louisville. During this time, the Southern Gospel Music Hall of Fame was still being held at Dollywood in Pigeon Forge, Tennessee. It was separate from the NQC event. When the Hall of Fame contract with Dollywood was not renewed, the Hall Of Fame was without a home to house all the thousands of items, including plaques of all the Hall of Fame individuals. It was then that the NQC board stepped up and incorporated the Hall of Fame events into the yearly National Quartet Convention and a ministry in Pigeon Forge provided part of its building to house the displays of hundreds of items!

I took my immediate family through the Hall of Fame display and realized that a great amount of the names we saw there are men and women I had sung on stage with since 1958!

Upon walking the halls of this year's convention and hearing the groups sing, I was so pleased to see and feel that these groups of today are sharing their talents with anointing and excellence! We need to support them.

Until next time, my heart will go on singing...
